



PUBLIC POLICY STATEMENTS 2023

Local

- The Chamber of Commerce supports Georgia Northwestern Technical College, Dalton State College, and Catoosa County Public Schools in programs and initiatives such as Apprenticeships, Dual Enrollment, and the From HERE to CAREER Academy to train a skilled workforce for the region's current and future employers.
- The Chamber of Commerce supports Catoosa County Public Schools Georgia Charter System initiative to provide career exploration and awareness activities in grades kindergarten through twelfth.
- The Chamber supports regional partnerships between local governments, the business community, K-12 and post-secondary education partners, philanthropic organizations, and the public for the purpose of fostering economic growth and development.
